No radios or cell phones or communication devices of any kind may be used to contact anyone and/or be contacted with any fishing related question/information during competition hours. Communication with Event Staff and/or emergency services is acceptable. Social media communication of any kind is prohibited during Event hours.

INFORMATION: Tournament competitors may share information with each other up to and after competition hours. However, no communication between teams whatsoever is allowed via cell phone, VHF radio, pager or any electronic device during competition, except for medical emergency as allowed under rule #20, or boat breakdown under rule #13. Teams are prohibited from discussing any fishing related information with anyone via electronic means during the tournament hours. Use of social media, websites, or other electronic devices to obtain and use information as a means to catch fish is prohibited.

The use of Social Media (such as Facebook) during tournament hours in regards to tournament related communication falls under the communication rule below:

There is to be NO electronic communication between competing anglers, or communication regarding fishing or the tournament during the competition.

Assistance: During hours of competition, anglers may not receive fishing information from non-competitors or participant in the practice of "hole sitting." The use of mobile communication devices such as cellular phones, marine radios, walkie-talkies, CBs, etc., to communicate fishing information during tournament hours is strictly prohibited. In the event of an emergency situation, anglers should call 911 first and then notify officials.

Communication During Tournament Hours: No communication will be allowed from outside sources during tournament hours. Information shared between two teams during tournament hours may not be used to give either team an advantage over other teams. No communication is allowed via cell phone, radio, pager or any other electrical device during competition hours. If a team has an emergency, a mechanical problem, or needs immediate assistance, teams may contact local authorities, emergency services, the Coast Guard or the tournament director. Teams must notify the tournament director immediately if these circumstances exist.

The use of mobile communication devices such as cellular phones, marine radios, walkie talkies, CBs, etc. to communicate fishing information during tournament hours is strictly prohibited. No hole sitting by competitor or non-competitor boat during the tournament. The use of Aqua View or other underwater cameras is also prohibited.

SHARING OF INFORMATION

Communication between Teams during tournament hours is strictly prohibited. This includes the use of cellular phones, vhf radios or any other communication devices. Exceptions are allowed in emergency situations.

No third-party fishing during the event. Each team must fish on their own without assistance except medical. Family members or friends who are not in the competition may not fish within established tournament boundaries. No communication/sharing of information between teams that may give another team a fishing advantage.

COMMUNICATIONS: We encourage you to unplug and really enjoy the Wild and scenic stretch of The Mississippi River you will be fishing. The use of mobile communication devices such as cellular telephones, marine radios, walkie-talkies, CBs, pagers or any electronic device to communicate fishing information during tournament hours is strictly prohibited. Communication among anglers is allowed on the water only by non-electronic methods. Emergency calls may be made. Using social media to post your highlights, or lowlights, during the event is allowed but please use the hashtag #CWOMN.
