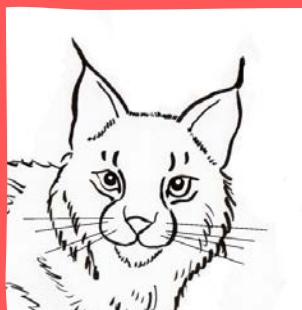

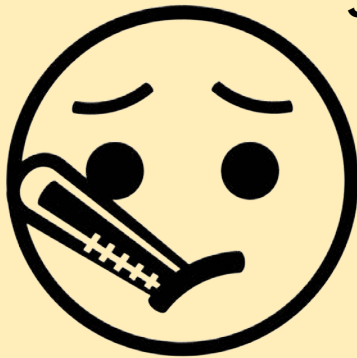
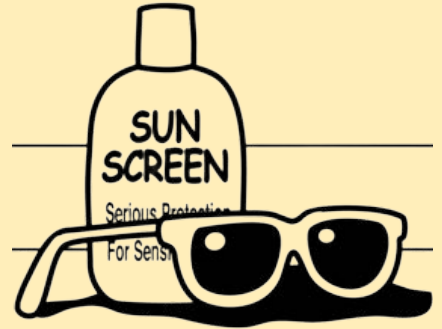


What plant am I?
