



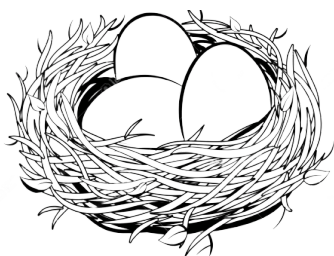
# Birds and their eggs



With the descriptions given, color the bird and its eggs to match. Then, check online to see if you colored the eggs and the birds correctly.

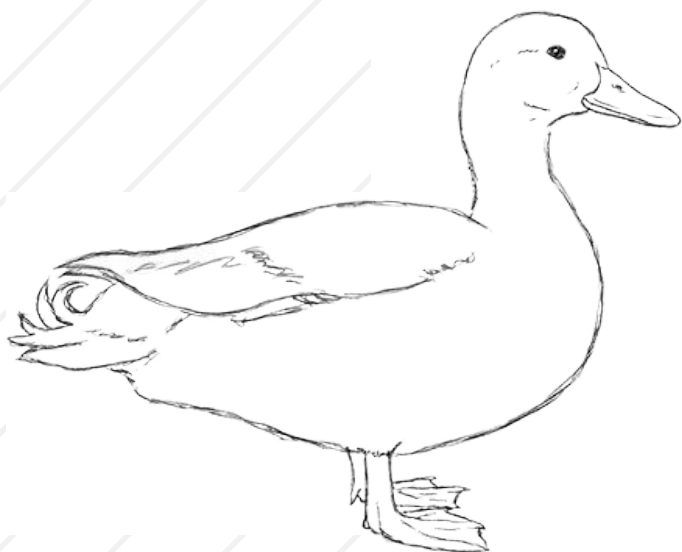
## Anhinga

Adult male Anhingas are black with silvery to white streaks on the back and wings. Females and immatures have a pale tan head, neck, and chest. The bill, legs, and feet are yellowish orange. Their eggs are pale bluish green.



## Mottled Duck

Mottled ducks are “dabbling ducks” that feed on vegetation at the surface of water. They are mostly brown ducks with a yellow bill and have blue secondary wings. Their eggs are whitish to a pale olive color.



# Green Heron

At first glance, Green Herons look all dark. In better light, they are deep green on the back with a chestnut colored chest and neck. The wings are dark gray and their feet and legs are orange. Green heron eggs are pale green to bluish.



# Yellow-crowned Night Heron

Adults are mainly gray with a large white cheek patch and yellow crown or head plumes. Their legs are orange-yellow. Like the green heron and anhinga, their eggs are a pale bluish green.
